American Bank Note Co., Fort Lee, NJ Supplier Performance Award

American Bank Note Co. helped the Postal Service develop a network of retail and financial consignees that allow customers to purchase stamps.

Ashton Potter Security Printers, Williamsville, NY Supplier Performance Award

Ashton Potter Security Printers produces postage stamps, postcards, envelopes and related products for the Postal Service.

AT&T, Dallas Supplier Performance Award

AT&T provides the Postal Service with several telecommunications services, including broadband, Internet and wireless communications.

Deloitte, Arlington, VA Supplier Performance Award

Deloitte, a consulting firm, helped the Postal Service reduce operating costs, increase revenue and develop new programs.

PAE, Arlington, VA

Supplier Performance Award

PAE is responsible for operations and warehousing services for the Postal Service's Mail Transport Equipment (MTE) service centers, which receive, inspect, package, repair, store and ship MTE.

Victory Packaging, Houston

Supplier Performance Award

VP delivers package supplies and ReadyPost products from 19 distribution centers, which are typically located within 50 miles of a Postal Service Network Distribution Center.

General Information Services, Chapin, SC

Supplier Excellence Award

General Information Services worked with the Postal Service to develop an innovative process to order and receive background checks through the eCareer system.

Honeywell Scanning and Mobility, Fort Mill, SC

Supplier Excellence Award

Honeywell Scanning and Mobility provides the Postal Service with scanners and handheld mobile computers for package tracking.

International Paper, Memphis

Supplier Excellence Award

International Paper supplies the Postal Service with corrugated MTE products.

MBA Consulting Services, Chantilly, VA

Supplier Excellence Award

MBA Consulting Services helps support the Postal Service's recycling program.

ATR Corp., Columbia, MD

Supplier Innovation Award

ATR Corp., a minority-owned engineering firm, helped manufacture Passive Adaptive Scanning System carts that provide visual and audio feedback to Postal Service employees on postage and routing.

Gable Signs & Graphics Inc., Baltimore

Supplier Innovation Award

Gable Signs and Graphics designs, manufactures and delivers corporate and retail signage for more than 32,000 Postal Service facilities nationwide.

Hollingsworth Logistics Group, Dearborn, MI

Hollingsworth Logistics Group, a minority-owned business, provides warehousing and contract packing and order fulfillment for the MTE service centers.

Asset LifeCycle, a woman-owned business, recycles Postal Service excess electronics and waste materials through a no-cost, revenue-sharing contract.

Supplier Sustainability Excellence Award

Southern Mail Service, a woman-owned business, provides mail transportation via highway contract routes for the Postal Service and also operates several terminal facilities.

Florence Manufacturing Co. designed and produced several prototype products to make outdoor mail and package delivery more efficient and effective for Postal Service carriers and customers.
